Thank you for the opportunity to engage with the Australian Government about its a review of the Determination under paragraph (c) of the definition of "broadcasting service" (No. 1 of 2000), ("The Alston Determination") which supplements the definition of a 'broadcasting service' in the Broadcasting Services Act 1992.
